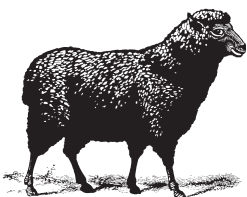


HUGH HAMILTON SKIN DEEP

STORY

We wondered 'What would happen if we treated a white wine like a red and left it to ferment on skins?' While we weren't certain this would make it into a bottle it seemed like fun nonetheless; but beyond just seeming fun this wine proved itself worthy of sharing. A beauty more than skin deep.

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Skin contact, the time we leave the juice in contact with the skins of the berries, can be a double-edged blade. For white wines it's all about balancing the extra flavour intensity with an increase in texture. The result is a wine poised between a decadent white and a fleshy red.

BOUQUET AND PALATE

Musk and gunpowder ride rough-shod over a brambly bed of spice, mandarin, lemon rind, pastilles, and pear drops. Elderflower, jasmine, cinnamon and straw. Utterly lush, but structured still, it grips like a suede chamois. Finishing in a savoury flourish of gummy spice.
