Our cast of characters are bottled up in some of Australia's finest wines. The Flock are our favourite classic varietals each with their own unique personality. Rebels. Reprobates. Rapscallions.

THE DRAMA QUEEN Méthode Traditionnelle

BLEND-52% Pinot Noir 38% Chardonnay 10% Pinot Meunier COLOUR—Pale salmon-pink

THE SENSES—An entire bakery of brioche. Early season strawberries rose petals, pink lady apples, and just a titch of bay leaf. Berry-bagel and proper pretzel, all with the very lightest citrus twist. Hiding behind the fruit. deeper savoury characters. A multitude of bubbles ride light amidst the creamy texture. Crisp and linen-fresh it is phenomenally lingering and intense.

ENJOY WITH—Canapes: bright tastv norsels ideally delivered with a flouris by impeccably trained wait staff at vour favourite restaurant. Or anywhere , really, it'll still be tasty.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE-'Every winery needs an attention seeking exaggerated, overly emotional, dramatic diva. Sometimes it's the winemaker, sometimes the boss, or sometimes a family member Fortunately not here, so we had to create one

DRINK—While this wine does not require further aging you can comfortably leave this lying in the cellar for the next five years.

THE TRICKSTER 2015 Pinot Grigio

VARIETAL—Pinot Grigio COLOUR—Brilliant pale straw THE SENSES— White pear to peach and a breeze of gum florals. Fresh linen. Lemon curd palate deliciously pink lady laden. Elastic band tana stretch and snap. Crunchy, complete and satisfying. Fleet footed and all verve. Clarity and class.

ENJOY WITH-If it swims, has fins and scales and goes glub glub you are onto a winner.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—' Few varieties capture both lightness of touch and depth of flavour as well as Pinot Grigio. These are grapes that can express themselves feather-light and pale as crystal, or full bodied and steel tinged. We aim at the former light, brillight, and fresh, Ideal for days of perfect blue skies. DRINK—Now through 1 year.

NEW RELEASE VARIETAL-Fiano COLOUR-Brilliant straw THE SENSES—A meadow of florals fresh with dew. Honeysuckle, lemon blossom, thyme. Brioche, custard powder, and oven bronzed pastry Lemon grass and sorbet. Florals waft through to the palate. Taut and crisp. Succulent citrus swaggers sun dazed throughout. Lightly textured with a grip that gives shape

VARIETAL—Chardonnav COLOUR—Brilliant straw THE SENSES—Striking and subtle and satisfying, the Scally sidles up and says 'enjoy'. All white peaches, creamy/toasty oak, both bay and lemon leaves, and also a titch of vanilla and sage leaf. A swaggerous Scallywag that knows it's good and doesn't mind telling you all about it

ENJOY WITH—Baked rainbow trout with lemongrass, steamed pak choi and coconut rice.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—'The amazina array of soils and topographies in McLaren Vale make an amazing range of styles and wines possible here. This Scallywag is sourced from the roof of the Vale, just a stone's throw from the Adelaide Hills, and yet retains all the best parts of its regional identity.

DRINK-Now through 2 years for reliable pleasure MOOD-Relaxed

THE FLOOZIE 2022 Sangiovese Grenache Rosé

VARIETAL—Sangiovese Grenache COLOUR—Pale Salmon pink THE SENSES—Pink ladies and cherry stones. Shifting shades

ENJOY WITH— Match delicate flavours to match this delicate wine – perhaps a pear, parmesan and walnut salad?

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—'The angio from Church can tend toward exuberance in both flavour and colour – making it easy to accidentally create a table wine where a rose was the intention We temper this tendency with a healthy dose of fruit from Digs Vinevard - a higher and cooler site yielding more delicate flavours; making the tremendous balance in this wine possible

DRINK- Now through 1 year MOOD—Flirtatious

From these we carefully took cuttings, just as has been dor for thousands of years, and stuck them into the ground at our McLare Vale home, continuina a generation old legacy; and they love it here. DRINK-Now through 2 years for liable pleasure

THE VILLAIN Cabernet Sauvignon

VARIETAL—Cabernet Sauvianon COLOUR—Deep crimson

THE SENSES—iIntense varietal lift. Brambly black fruit backed with sliced cayenne, paprika, areen olives, and roast chestnut A garden of lift: Dried thyme. oregano, and effusive florals sprouting exotically throughout Sandalwood, cinnamon, and rose Split stone, graphite, and blood. Supple, muscular, taut, poised.

ENJOY WITH-Roast beef short ribs, soutéed wild mushrooms with fresh parsley.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—'The Cabernet from the Black Sheep Block is fleet on it's feet, having more high tone perfume and exotic spices. Comparatively, the Cabernet arown at Cellar Block tends more toward weight and texture. Careful blending of the

two blocks produces a wine of both presence and elegance. This is the Villoin DRINK- 2-6 years. MOOD— Rebellious

Rascal is a celebration of the three distinct styles that are achieved on these sites when the vines are tended carefully and the wine made with absolute respect for time and place.

DRINK-Still fresh, the best is vet to flesh out. 4-12 years.

COLOUR-Vibrant crimson/ purple

THE SENSES—A big soft punch of plums, honey-bacon, and a whole field of multiple florals India ink. rosemary, coal, and raspberry. Soft, lip smacking, smoochy palate. Pulpy fresh and bright. Lolls like caramel; lingering. Moocher speed.

ENJOY WITH— Pan fried maple and apple pork chops, or a roast beetroot and butternut pumpkin salad with tahini

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—'The rows of the Church vinevard are hemmed in by a creek at one end and an enormous old aum at the other. Many years this can mean one end is dipping its toes in the water while the other is getting fairly thirsty. I think the range of flavours we see rolling about this wine is, at least in part due to this variation along each row. Rich fruit but still crisp and with tremendous structure.

THE SENSES—Begins with a frisson of fine French oak and smoky sandalwood before plunging into a full fruit basket; plums, mulberries, blackberries and blackcurrants. The palate pulses with fruit filled verve. . Rosehip, and cocoa notes Leather, bay, and thyme.

ENJOY WITH-Slow roast lea of lamb or rosemary aarlic hasselback potatoes, but probably both just to be sure.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—'It's well known that McLaren Vale makes great Shiraz, but less well known is that Vale Cahernet can also excel. With aood harvestina decisions you can create a blend with lift and elegance but also with a rich full palate. Something I believe we have achieved with our Larrikin.

sustained, the Pedro is a nasterpiece made possible only by time and patience: so long in fact that the wine has long ago outlived the vineyard which made it.

DRINK—Drink whenever, this wine will age indefinitely. Once opened, consume with haste

THE SENSES—Lively fruit belies the time that has fined the bouquet bringingdepth and flavour - but not at the cost of primary fruit. Rose petalred eather. Cocoa powder and dates.

ENJOY WITH—This is not a wine built for fish or fine white sauces. lift your dame with dame oraged mushrooms and butter lots of butter.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—'There's a bravery in embracing big and this is a wine where everything ng big and towers tall. The darkest fraction of a wine leaves the winepress last - loaded with enormous amounts of all of the characte that make a wine areat - and we took only of this fraction and aged it in 100% new oak barrels A lesser wine would be flooded b that much barrel: only the areat can take it.

DRINK—Leave it longer than you hink you should, maybe longer than you think you can - 6-15 years

Elusive and fiercely independent Black Sheep wines that will not be pinned down. The Dark Arts is a range of wines from varieties that are not meant to go together, but work! They refuse to be part of the status quo; they are wine as art.



JEKYLL & HYDE Shiraz Viognie

BLEND—92% Shiraz, 8% Viognier COLOUR-Deep purple shot with

THE SENSES—Strawberry lader thunder rolls overhead; a fresh haked nie filled with cherries and apples steams on a windowsill; the dense scent of pastry crust thick in the air. Fragrant whorls of red fruit. cranberry, black pepper, bubblegum rosehips, and slate. The palate plays hide-and-seek sayoury to sweet Tannins taut. Alive and lithe. Leather slap, cherry smack. A whip crack whack of smart fruit.

ENJOY WITH- Spiced slow roast lamb, mushroom beet risotto as a side or a main

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—'There aren't nany occasions where adding a lighter colour leads to one which is darker, however the Jekyll is just tha kind of paradox. By co-fermenting the two varieties the Vioanier skins help form more stable complexes, and thereby a darker colour. There are other changes too that modulate and intensify flavour; all part of the strange case that is Jekyll and Hyde. DRINK-2-8 vears

DRINK- Now through 3 years

A confectionary/ savoury see-saw where rhubarb rubs up close against almond and apple blossom. A fulcrum of black fruit. Sorry-not-sorry tannins, ever palate present, lengthy, elegant, and pleasant

EN.JOY WITH- Smoky BBQ - ribs, brisket, shoulder, 'shrooms or aubergines.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE— 'Australia has always excelled in creating red blends - merging classic European varieties in un-thought of ways to create unthinkably good new combinations. This, not so classic collision combines fruits of Abruzzo Portugal and Bordeaux in a complete Contiki style tour of 'Euro' flavour, Aussie style.

ENJOY WITH-Remarkably robust the Madam will consort readily with many dishes - try roast peking duck, or a roast mushroom hoisin noodle

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—'Sparkling Red is a curiously Australian invention, further testament to our fearless try-it-and-see attitude. Made in the same way as Champagne is traditionally produced we have pulled out all the stops here - secondary fermentation in bottle, time on lees, riddling and disgorgement, and finally tirage. If these strange words mean nothing to you, have no fear, it's delicious Shiraz, just with bubbles in it ; enjoy

DRINK—Now through 5 years

NEW VINTAGE The exotic bedding brilliantly with the familiar. Blood and blueberries. Plums on a butchers block. Hibiscus smoke, rosehip,

candied rhubarb and black pepper. Shifting aromatically like a pulsing ocean: at once primary and savoury. The palate rolling rollicking, then finishing with a lick of incense. ENJOY WITH-Keep it simple

and solid – lamb shanks, and/ or roasted and herbed root vegetables.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—'Vintage 2019 threw some c our way in the form of a very dry summer and prolonged heat. It is no coincidence that the vinevard selections for the Black Sheep are from blocks that are traditionally harvested early: Being able to take advantage of the dry weather, and avoid the heat, led to excellent fruit quality with enormous depth of flavour

ANCIENT EARTH 2020 Shiraz

NEW VINTAGE

VARIETAL—Shiraz COLOUR-Purple-black

THE SENSES—Charcoal plums. Cherry, rosehip, and violets ride raucous over charcuterie, cumin and leather-bound French oak. Graphite tight. An ever-present blackberry backdrop; though never hefty. Pops of fruit lobbed like cherry bombs right in the middle of a grand wave of fine tannin. Somehow slick yet rustic

ENJOY WITH—Garlic butter roast portobello mushrooms with nolenta or herh-crusted ton loin beef roast with all the sides.

WINEMAKER'S NOTE—'An assembly of excellent parcels sourced from a cross-section of McLaren Vale to create a regional expression of Shiraz. I contrast to the Black Bloods that highlight sub-regions, Ancient Earth aims to target the highest auality subregions across the entire area and blend them into a seamless representation of what the Vale does best.

COLOUR— Deep crimson fades to black in the depths of the alass

THE SENSES— Boondocks liquor and sporty fruit. High-violet and a crackling fire. Smoky plum, star anise, bubbleaum, Clouds precedent to a storm and all the lightning too. Sparking out of the alass - snappy raspberry, vanilla pod, coconut, and split redgum.

The palate is massive, a flavour firecracker. Aromatic, portentous and pure. This is a circus-train running on straight rails direct to your skull. Endlessly entertaining,
