STORY

WINEMAKER'S NOTES

Grenache is a great solo artist, and also strong enough to happily share the stage. The subtle interplay of Grenache, Shiraz and Mataro leaves no second fiddles in this trio. It's just a matter of fine tuning how much and where.

BOUQUET AND PALATE

An audacious cascade of bright raspberry and cherry backed by donut glaze and sourdough. Cinnamon and ginger; marvellous. A succulent palate slides, and grips at the sides, as all the while it glides, reverberating and ululating. A core of red fruit the very eye of the storm of darker berries, eddying all over. Plush and rolling.

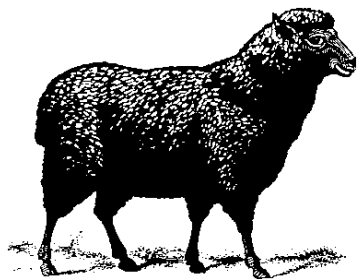
